Change the middle ‘N’ to an ‘E’ and add an ‘E’ at the end.

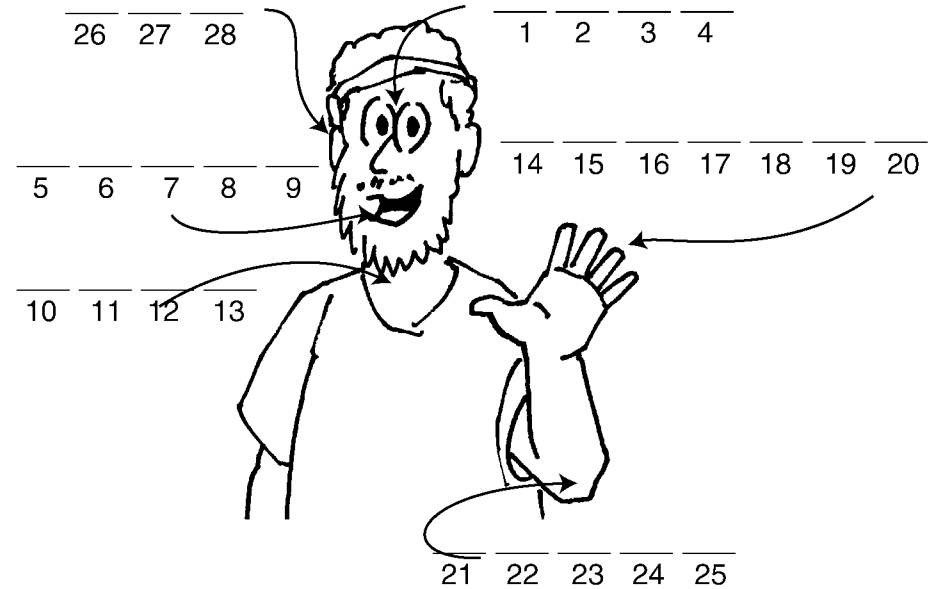
Change the first letter to a ‘C’.
